

Types of Word Study Sorts

All of these activities have been explicitly taught and practiced in the classroom.

Closed Sort: Set up your headers. Use your headers to sort your words.

Speed Sort: Set up your headers and shuffle your words. Set a timer, then sort your words correctly and as fast as you can. Record your time. Do this at least 3 times.

Blind Sort: Set up your headers. Have a family member read a word to you without letting you see it. Point to the header that the word belongs with. Keep going until all of your words have been read.

Writing Sort: Write your headers at the top of a piece of paper. Shuffle your words. Draw one word card, then write that word under the correct header. Keep going until all of your words have been written.

Blind Writing Sort: Write your headers at the top of a piece of paper. Have a family member read a word to you without letting you see it. Write that word under the correct header. Keep going until all of your words have been written.

Word Hunt: Write your headers at the top of a piece of paper. Look through books, newspapers, and magazines to find words that would fit under your headers. When you find a word, write it under the correct header.
